This course must be completed before taking the NUR-304 Healthy Aging course. NUR 250 Nutrition if offered online every Fall and Spring Semester. You will need to complete a course overlap form for the semester you register for the online NUR 250 Nutrition for Wellness course.

The required credits for the following courses must be obtained **prior to beginning NUR-301 Holistic Health Assessment** in order to be eligible to continue in Notre Dame of Maryland University's Accelerated RN to BSN program:

Introduction to Psychology Anatomy & Physiology I & II Human Growth and Development Microbiology Introduction to Sociology Electives

You may obtain the credits required by completing these courses at Notre Dame or by successfully completing approved Excelsior exams or CLEP tests.

Excelsior Exams

Excelsior exams may be successfully completed to fulfill the following Nursing Department Requirements:

- Human Anatomy & Physiology I & II
- Microbiology

These exams are taken at local Prometric testing centers. You can schedule your testing appointment online at <u>www.excelsior.edu</u>. Study guides are also available and can be ordered online as well.



CLEP Tests

CLEP tests may be successfully completed to fulfill the following Nursing Department Requirements:

- Introduction to Psychology
- Human Growth and Development
- Introduction to Sociology
- General Electives

CLEP tests may be taken at your local community college. Information about CLEP testing is available online at <u>www.collegeboard.com/clep</u>. On the day of your exam you will be able to indicate where the official transcript should be sent. You should select Notre Dame of Maryland.

Once the College of Adult Undergraduate Studies (CAUS) has received your official transcripts from these exams/tests indicating passing scores, you will be notified that the transcript was received and informed of how many credits you need to post to your Notre Dame transcript. There is a \$10.00 posting fee assessed per credit. You must post the credits earned through these exams/tests within 30 days.

- In the event that you do not obtain the credits for these School of Nursing required courses prior to the beginning of NUR-301 Holistic Health Assessment, your progress in the CAUS Nursing Program will be interrupted until you successfully complete the courses.
- If you do not successfully complete the Nutrition requirement prior to the date when your cohort is scheduled to take NUR-304 Healthy Aging, you may have to change to a different cohort to continue progressing in the program. Changing cohorts may result in a new location and an increase in your tuition rate per credit.
