## PharmD/MBA in Healthcare Management Joint Program

CURRICULUM 2023/2024 (48 CREDIT PROGRAM)

#### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

An MBA in Healthcare Management from Clarkson University prepares students for the rigors of business and healthcare. The curriculum is designed to help students understand the complexities of the healthcare system and manage health and health-related facilities more effectively. Graduates go on to successful careers as administrators, providers, and analysts in healthcare, governmental and private sector organizations with strong healthcare interests. Clarkson's comprehensive program provides an intimate learning environment and is one of a select few programs in the country to offer dual AACSB and CAHME accreditation.

NDMU pharmacy students can enroll in the joint program beginning in the second semester of third (P3) year. Students will be full-time at NDMU and part-time at Clarkson.

### **CURRICULUM** (16 courses, 48 credits)

Courses are available online or in a traditional classroom environment at Clarkson's Capital Region Campus. All students must complete and/or have waived the required core courses.

#### **NDMU PARTNERSHIP**

NDMU pharmacy students can waive 3 courses and transfer in 1 course as an elective. This reduces the program by a total of four classes!

Additionally, all NDMU pharmacy students are given a \$2000 partnership scholarship upon enrollment into the MBA. This scholarship is allocated <u>in addition to</u> any other scholarships that the student earns.

Lastly, the 400 hour internship is waived for NDMU pharmacy students.

#### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**
