New Transfer Student: Applying to the nursing major is a two-step process – one application is filed for admission to the University and a supplemental application is filed for acceptance into the School of Nursing.

PROCESS

- All applications received by February 15 will be reviewed for priority consideration. Applications are only considered complete if official transcripts from all colleges/universities are received. NDMU transcripts must be requested by the student.
- You may be requested to schedule an interview during the review process with the School of Nursing Admissions and Progressions Circle.
- You will receive a letter regarding acceptance into the nursing major.
- All decisions for acceptance are conditional: You must continue to meet the admission and progression criteria in subsequent semesters if needed for all course work completed at NDMU or elsewhere. In addition, the Test of Essential and Academic Skills (TEAS) exam is a requirement for progression.
