WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU REPORT:

- » Confidentiality, Sensitivity, and Respect
- » Be Provided with Rights/Resources
- » Discuss potential Supportive/Interim Measures
- » Understand the process for pursuing a University investigation and resolution of the complaint.

TYPES OF REPORTS

UNIVERSITY	LAW ENFORCEMENT	JUDICIAL
Guided by the reporting party, this could result in documenting a complaint with the University up to an investigation and resolution process resulting in sanctions for the responding party.	This could result in a criminal investigation of the responding party, and subsequent criminal charges being filed. Crime victims and witnesses are provided with additional rights and services under the law.	This could result in a Protection or Peace Order being issued by a judge to prevent/stop the responding party from contacting or committing certain acts against the reporting party.
