

# External Scholarships for Current High School Seniors entering college Fall of 2019

### Abott and Fenner Scholarship

- Eligibility: High school juniors and seniors and current undergraduate students.
- Award Amount: \$1,000

### **AES Engineering Scholarship**

- Eligibility: High School seniors and current undergraduates may apply. Do not need to take any engineering courses to be eligible.

### Edward T. Conroy Memorial Scholarship Program

- Eligibility: Student must be a Maryland resident and be the son or daughter of a Maryland resident killed or disabled in the line of duty as a state or local public service employee, or member of the US Armed Forces.
- Award Amount: The amount of your award may not exceed the equivalent annual tuition and mandatory fees, of a resident undergraduate at a four-year public institution of higher education within the University System of Maryland, other than the University of Maryland University College and the University of Maryland, Baltimore, with the highest annual expenses for a full-time resident undergraduate.
