American Association of University Women (AAUW): Baltimore Chapter

- Eligibility: Woman pursuing a baccalaureate degree who has complete at least two years of college (junior standing) and has had her studies interrupted at some point for at least 6 months.
- Award Amount: \$1,000

- Eligibility: High school juniors and seniors and current undergraduate students.

- Eligibility: Any Student Athlete that is a High School Senior or current Undergraduate Student

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and graduate students. Must be a degree-seeking Maryland resident. 1 application enters you into 40 different scholarships!

- Eligibility: Undergraduate students whose residence is in the zip code range of 20600-20699 or 21000-21999. Students must submit an essay (550 words or less) that describes their experience, achievements, and goals.
